- 8 certified paramedics
- 1 rescue and 1 engine equipped with extrication tools
- Dive team for three area lakes
- All medical direction through the Rolling Plains Memorial Hospital
- Life support services
- 3 air ambulance services in the surrounding areas available for emergency transports


