Median household income is \$24.3K below the national median household income of \$69.0K.

Takeaways

- As of 2022 the region's population declined by 2.9% since 2017, falling by 439. Population is expected to increase by 0.5% between 2022 and 2027, adding 68.
- From 2017 to 2022, jobs increased by 0.7% in Sweetwater, TX from 6,779 to 6,829. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.8% by 3.1%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate increased from 59.7% to 60.2% between 2017 and 2022.
- Concerning educational attainment, **11.1% of Sweetwater**, **TX residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (9.8% below the national average), and **7.9% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.9% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Lime and Gypsum Product Manufacturing, and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.







Top Growing Occupations


